	<p>4-H Camp – Each summer, youth ages 9-13 have the opportunity to attend one, fun-filled week at West Kentucky 4-H Camp in Dawson Springs. Information is sent out through the schools in early Spring.</p>
	<p>Reality Store – 4-H works with the middle schools to provide this economic look into the “real world for Marshall County 8th graders. Students learn how far (or not) a monthly paycheck goes when providing for a family, utilities, home, car, and other daily necessities without breaking the bank.</p>
	<p>Youth Ag Field Day – 4-H collaborates with the Conservation District to teach Marshall County 4th grade students about agriculture and how it impacts their lives. Topics include grains, bee keeping, tobacco, farming history, pest management, etc.</p>
	<p>Farm & Home Safety Day – Teaches 5th graders how to be safer at home and out on the farm. Students learn about different safety issues related to electricity, poisons, water, lawn/farm equipment, and more.</p>
